It's a haven for wellness, flavour and mystery with a rush of adrenaline for anyone who wants to get to grips with Camargue traditions.

It's a land of contrasts that come together here among the vineyards and lagoons.

The Camargue Gardoise stands out for its signature scenery and ecosystem.

The area is famous for its traditions, bulls and outstanding natural heritage that earned it the Grand Site de France label in January 2014, which it intends to hold onto.

It has a zest for life and is true to its roots and traditions. Summer is a prime time for hosting bull-themed events.

The Canal du Rhône à Sète runs through our land from east to west. It connects the wetlands to the Costières.

The Camargue and its sprawling reed beds lie to the south. They provide a hidden, cosy nest for birds, a migration area for others and a fantastic biodiversity habitat for a unique array of wildlife and plants.

The Costières hillside vineyards are home to scenery with incredible views on the other side of the canal to the north. These AOP vineyards melt into the garrigue.

But wherever you are, as you drink in the landscapes from north to south, east to west and back again, you won't be able to resist the call of the lush greenery on one side and glittering blue on the other. The Costières and Camargue gradually melt into each other: the Petite Camargue.

The people who live in a place like this can't help but be true to their roots and give a warm welcome to anyone who wants to explore everything their "Land" has to offer. They can't wait to share their passion and love for this slice of paradise with anyone who wants to uncover it.

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## The Camargue gardoise, a land with two labels under its belt

### On a national level

The Camargue gardoise became the 14th area to be awarded the **Grand Site de France** label on January 14th by the Minister in charge of the Ecology and Sustainable Development. We earned the label for the importance of our wetlands and in recognition of their protection and promotion.

### On a regional level

The Camargue gardoise was awarded the **Grand Site Occitanie/Sud de France** label for its outstanding and world-famous natural, cultural and historical heritage.

## THE PETITE CAMARGUE or CAMARGUE GARDOISE

It brings together the Costières hillside vineyards and the sea, connecting the Hérault wetlands and Rhône delta.

### Why do we call it the "Cœur" of the Petite Camargue?

Because it captures the heart and soul of the Camargue:

- The diversity, wealth and beauty of its untamed landscapes.
- The passion of its locals and the "Fé di Bioù" (faith in the bull) that radiates from traditional festivals celebrating our Camargue culture.
- The contrast between our land's wild scenery and welcoming community. The strong personality of our passionate locals who love sharing their knowledge with you.

Our land captures the "heart" of the Camargue gardoise as it really is, without any fuss, frills or folklore. An "untamed" and natural land...

# HORSES AND BULLS

“ Fascinating wild animals who never cheat. ”



## A farming legacy

Manades are bull and/or horse farms.

Exploring the Camargue bull farms and their surroundings means meeting the farmers and the people who live in the Petite Camargue. We don't have the words to inspire you to visit them and experience magical, unique moments with them.

So what we have here is their own account on how they see their trade, their passion. These are their own words and thoughts.

*"Working as a farmer with Camargue bulls is a family affair. The aim of a manade is to produce a great cocardier from the herd and make a lifetime of work count."*

*Bulls are **fascinating wild animals** who never cheat. Manadiers work with gardians and see bulls almost like their own children. The bulls set the pace of life.*

*What fuels their bond is their respect for these honest and powerful beasts that roam free, "at home" on their pastures.*

*The Camargue horse is a workhorse that lives outside all year round. The Camargue's unique soil makes the breed what it is.*

*The manadier and gardian are nothing without a good horse. They build a relationship based on trust that enables them to pull off their sometimes tricky tasks with the bulls.*

*The Camargue saddle is a working saddle with a unique custom seat that has a pommel and a back rest.*

*If you see a black foal following its white mother, it's probably a purebred Camargue horse! Its coat lightens with age and starts turning white from the age of 3."*



Whilst you're in the Cœur de Petite Camargue, you may be lucky enough to meet these passionate people who invite visitors to live life in their shoes.

**They're not inviting you to a show;** they're inviting you to be part of their family and experience what they do.

As you explore, you may be in for an unexpected surprise such as taking the horses up to mountain pastures or moving the bulls to a new pasture. **Once-in-a-lifetime experiences, unforgettable memories, real people and the warmest welcome.**

## VEILLÉES CAMARGUAISES

This is your chance to meet manadiers and gardians.

Join them in the work they do every day as the gardians put the same skill and agility as their ancestors into everything they do.

This eye-opening and soul-stirring experience is elevated by a buzzing atmosphere and dinner showcasing local produce.



# CAMARGUE TRADITIONS

“Camargue traditions are an integral part of our land.”

After years and years of selective breeding, the bull has become an idol. All our festivals, or "fêtes votives" as the locals call them, celebrate bulls.

**The Courses Camarguaises are the main event.** It's like a game pitting the raseteurs against the bulls and recognised as a sport by the French Courses Camarguaises Federation.

The raseteurs dress in white and must grab cockades (badges and strings) off the bull's horns. The bravest bulls are called "cocardiers" and are the stars of the show.

Bull-related sports, known locally as "bouvine", have created a unique landscape in the towns and countryside. You'll be blown away by the barriers, arenas, empègues and tombs built in tribute to famous bulls.

**That's right, the great cocardiers die of old age and are given a proper burial by their owners.**

Listen to the villagers: they'll tell you to get behind the barriers when the bulls come into the village from the fields (abrivado) or when they head back out (bandido).



## Camargue cross

The "Croix de Camargue" or "Croix des Gardians" (herdsmen's cross) captures the Camargue's holy trinity:

- The cross and gardian's tridents embody faith
- The fisherman's anchor symbolises hope
- The heart represents the charity of the Three Marys, Jesus's disciples who settled in the Camargue

Marquis de Baroncelli commissioned the Parisian illustrator Hermann-Paul to design the Camargue cross in 1926.



## Bull tombs

The bull tombs are an unusual sight. Most of the bulls are buried on land owned by manadiers. The only exception is Le Sanglier's tomb in honour of the famous cocardier bull from Fernand Granon's manade (1920–1930), outside the village of Le Cailar.



## Fêtes Votives

Locals festivals run from spring right through to autumn. The traditional schedule is almost always the same. Locals meet in the fields in the morning where the gardians sort the bulls then lead them to the village.

An **abrivado** is when the bulls reach the village surrounded by horses.

The Course Camarguaise plays out in the arenas in the afternoon then the **bandido** sees the gardians herd the bulls out of the village streets.

### Can you spot a Camargue bull?

Its signature feature is the lyre-shaped horns.

It also stands out for its height (rarely more than 1.3m for males and 1.2m for females) and weight (300–450kg for males and 200–270kg for females).

Look out for the iconic Camargue beast's long and slim neck and dark, usually black, coat.



## Empègues

You're bound to spot little stencil prints on doorways in some villages: they are called "empègues".

Children in the village stencil them on during the Aubades (to raise funds for the Fête Votive).





# PROTECTED FLORA AND FAUNA

The **Camargue gardoise** has been listed as a **Grand Site de France** since 2014 because of heritage projects by local figures and its unique identity.

Our land is an outstanding and unspoilt place home to a whole host of traditions including breeding, hunting, fishing and "sagne" harvesting (Camargue reeds).

Only a handful of **sagneurs** are keeping the tradition of cutting and crafting reeds alive.

The lagoons and reed beds are a prime rest area for countless species of birds including 9 different species of herons.

You may well spot a **purple heron** or **cattle egret** which tends to sit on the backs of Camargue horses... not to be confused with the equally famous but black-beaked **little egret**.

You'll see the dark brown **western marsh harrier** circle overhead in search of prey.



But this bird of prey has to watch out for the **black-winged stilt** which may well chase it off to protect its young.

The **European pond turtle** reigns over the wetlands. It's one of few freshwater turtles in Europe and is highly protected. Monks used to eat it as a fish course on Fridays!

Another wetland resident is the **coypu**. It may look cute but it does damage other species' habitats when it digs its burrows. Countless birds feed off the fish, amphibians and dragonflies living in this wetland area surrounded by tamarisk trees.

**As the locals will tell you, the Camargue's secretive and mysterious reputation** exists for one good reason: to protect it! So you need to find the right people to let you into the inner circle and share their knowledge with you.

Don't worry, we're going to help you find them!







# AN OUTSTANDING LAND

## Hikes

Our destination has everything **you could wish for when it comes to cycling and hiking.**

**The flat Camargue** stands out for its open spaces and horizons, ideal if you want to go on long hikes and stop to look at the flora and fauna.

**The rolling Costières** is home to hills with some "puechs" (mountains) peaking at 130m. In the distance you have incredible views of the lagoons, Nîmes plain, garrigues and even the Cévennes and Pic Saint Loup in Hérault on clear days.

A variety of trails deep in the vines and orchards enable the keen ramblers among you to give yourself a challenge without having to deal with the gradients in steeper areas.

You may run into a pilgrim heading to **The Camino de Santiago**. Look out for the shell hanging off their backpacks!



## Heritage

The Cœur de Petite Camargue towns and villages are a melting pot of religions home to a world-famous Jewish school, Christian pilgrimage site and opulent Protestant churches.

Prosperous vine growing and the strong secular and republican local character have left us with fantastic architecture with some religious monuments bearing republican inscriptions!

Our land has always been criss-crossed by famous and little-known paths including the **Salt Road**, the first industrial road to bring in business. The best-known is the **Via Tolosana** or **Way of Arles**, one of 4 pilgrimage routes to Santiago de Compostela.

Notre Dame de Vauvert Church was an ancient prayer site for pilgrims.

**The Camino de Santiago is signposted as a GR®653 hiking trail.**

**The Canal du Rhône à Sète**, formerly Beaucaire Canal, is the land's natural meeting point. It brings the wetlands and Costières together and runs through our land from east to west, from the Rhône to the Canal du Midi.

Despite disruption and hostility from locals, the canal was built in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century and takes pride of place in our area.

River tourism is the driving force behind the port in Gallician welcoming amateur sailors all year round.

Sprawling reed beds cover the marshes and river-lake wetlands in the south.

There are also natural wet meadows that are protected by natural grazing from the Camargue bulls and horses.



**The Près de Le Cailar** is a striking example of them. The heart of the Petite Camargue is a little slice of heaven that will dazzle you with its beautiful landscapes, peace and quiet and the bond between nature, wildlife and mankind.

The locals say that life is so good here that some species of bird from northern climes come to nest here and never want to leave!

The **Costières hillside vineyards** are home to scenery with incredible views on the other side of the canal. Here you'll find polyculture, viticulture on pebbles and arboriculture.

**If you're lucky enough, you may spot a little bustard flying in the middle of the farmlands.**

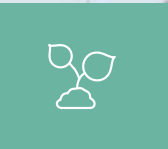

# BIKE RIDES

Our land is heaven for fans of **bicycle touring** and jam-packed with cycling routes. There are countless paths that rack up **over 60km of signposted trails for all abilities**.

- **The 7km greenway** from Vauvert to Gallician is a designated bike/footpath that's reserved exclusively for non-motorised journeys.
- **The ViaRhôna** or **Eurovélo 17** starts at Gallician Port. It's a greenway up to Le Grau-du-Roi then a shared road until Saint-Gilles then Beaucaire.
- **The Mediterranean Route** or **Eurovélo 8** explores the South of France with rides from the Alps to the Pyrenees.
- **Bicycle touring routes** are suitable for leisurely riders (the 17km Camargue Gardoise loop) and keen cyclists (the 23km Costières loop) alike. Put them together to give yourself a 40km challenge!

We also have a network of signposted trails ("From the Costières to the Camargue ponds" guide) to explore the great outdoors on your mountain bike.

# HIKES



## Hikes and walks

Whether you're a keen rambler or looking for a family outing with a difference, walk this way to explore the great outdoors in Camargues and the Costières hills.

From marked hiking trails to educational footpaths, take a walk in a land bursting with every shade of blue and green.

- The PR®52 "From one canal to another" signposted footpath is ideal for families starting at the port in Gallician (11km - 3hr).

- Our nature reserves are full of themed educational trails if you're with the kids or bird lovers (1-4km).

- 2 major hiking trails run through our area and are ideal for trekkers: the GR®653 in the north and GR®42 in the south.

## MAP AND HIKING GUIDES

We sell the "From the Costières to the Camargue ponds - Along the way to Santiago de Compostela" guidebook (5€). It details the entire network with over 120km of paths suitable for walkers, mountain bikers and horse riders. It also shows where you can hook up with footpaths and hiking trails in border areas.

Our other guidebooks include:

- The GR®42 "Du Pilat à la Méditerranée" guide (Pilat to Mediterranean)
- The GR®653 "Sentier vers Saint-Jacques-de-Compostelle" guide (Path to Santiago de Compostela)

## THE CAMINO DE SANTIAGO

The Way of Arles bridges the gap between the Mediterranean and the Atlantic. It runs from Arles to Puente-la-Reina in Spain where it hooks up with the Camino Francès within 1000km.

**Vauvert** is the third stage on the Way of Arles, after Arles and Saint-Gilles. It goes through **Beauvoisin** just behind Château Beaubois before it reaches Vauvert.

It continues into Gallargues-le-Montueux through the "lands" of **Le Cailar**.

The **GR®653 hiking trail** through town opened in 1990 and is **the last of the 4 trails of Compostela**. It's uninterrupted, well-signposted and has lots of places to stay. It's achievable no matter the season.

The route works both ways: to Rome and to Santiago de Compostela.

Some B&B owners provide discounted accommodation for pilgrims who show their **pilgrim passport\***.

Vauvert welcomes each and every pilgrim with open arms in the spirit of the "Way".

Pilgrims, you are welcome here all year round and we provide a range of services such as helping you find a place to stay, stamping your pilgrim passport and any information to help you on your way.

# HERITAGE

What we lack in ruins, we make up for in the marks left by history for you to uncover as you explore our area.

## Guided tours

### CHÂTEAU DE TEILLAN

**Château de Teillan** is home to listed romantic landscaped grounds which were built around stone tablets and Roman milestones in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.

You can see a fantastic 16<sup>th</sup> century dovecote and chapterhouse at the château. Self-guided tour with visitor booklet.

**July 15th–August 31st: open daily (exc. Monday) 2pm–8pm. Open to groups of 10–40 people the rest of the year (booking required).**

## Self-guided tours

### FRANQUEVAUX ABBEY TOUR

This path through the hamlet takes you on a trip back in time to meet the Franquevaux monks. Franquevaux Abbey was built in 1143 and has now been split into several unique homes.

**Start at Espace J. Torrès** (Parking des Arènes car park).

Along the way you'll see 5 boards detailing life at the abbey. Your trip ends on Pont de Franquevaux bridge with incredible views of the Canal du Rhône à Sète and the lagoons around it. Soak up the setting where the abbey was built.

This educational trail links into our footpath network. You can venture south on the GR®42 along the Canal du Rhône à Sète or hook up with The Camino de Santiago on the GR®653 to the north.

Camargue bull meat is surprisingly delicate and very lean.

Bull breeding is called extensive farming because of the limited number of bulls per hectare.

5 manadiers breeding Camargue bulls founded the *Syndicat de Défense et de Promotion de la viande AOC de taureau de Camargue* in 1992 (Union to Champion and Promote AOC Camargue Bull Meat).

They earned the first AOC for beef in France in 1996.

The EU had the AOC changed to AOP in 2008.

# RESTAURANTS

As you wind your way through our beautiful land from Camargue to Costières, you'll see how the vineyard has sculpted the landscape and captured the bond between the land and wine. Countless wineries have transitioned to organic farming over the last few years in all the area's designations.

The **Costières de Nîmes** designation is the biggest one in our area. Between the sea and Cévennes, the vineyard covers the plateaus and hillsides overlooking the Rhône delta and Mediterranean coast. The Costières de Nîmes soil mainly contains round pebbles and clay-limestone.

Costières de Nîmes is made from all kinds of grape varieties. Red and rosé tend to use classic grapes such as syrah, grenache and mourvèdre with carignan and cinsault in supporting roles. White wine is made using grenache blanc, roussanne and marsanne. At least two varieties must be blended in all three colours.

Further south, **Sable de Camargue** was given an AOP in 2023 and is an outstanding terroir where vines grow in the sand on former dunes. It stands out for its finesse, delicate touch, light body and carefree vibe. The popular **grey, gris de gris and rosé wines** capture the terroir with their blush hue, smooth mouthfeel and fresh flavour. **They account for 94% of production. "Vin gris" or grey wine is a very pale wine.** The aromas are soft and gentle, just like the surrounding Camargue scenery.

IGP **Pays d'Oc** is the 3<sup>rd</sup> wine-growing terroir in our area. Pays d'Oc wine is fruity, exciting, sophisticated and contemporary.

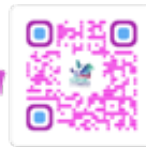
